

Claremont MakerSpace Member Access Rules

In order to ensure the safety of our members and community, the Claremont MakerSpace continues to adhere to New Hampshire and CDC guidelines regarding COVID-19 safety.

Members must read, and agree to abide by the terms, conditions, policies and procedures outlined here in order to continue to be granted access to the Claremont MakerSpace.

Members who fail to comply with these policies will have their membership suspended. We expect all members to comply with rules and requests made by our employees and volunteer staffers who are charged with ensuring the health and safety of the premises.

At this time, we are pleased to announce that we are loosening restrictions for **fully vaccinated members**, as per New Hampshire and CDC guidance. In general, people are considered fully vaccinated:

- 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or
- 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine

If you do not meet these requirements you are NOT fully vaccinated and you are expected to follow all CMS guidelines for unvaccinated individuals, including not entering the facility during the recommended isolation period after possible exposure

and wearing a mask at all times while at the Claremont MakerSpace.

We reserve the right to request proof of vaccination status in order to determine compliance.

Access hours:

Normal membership level access hours have been restored. You can access the MakerSpace during the hours specified by your membership level, which are:

- **Nights & Weekend Membership**
 - Monday – Friday, 5pm – 9pm; Weekends, 8am – 9pm
- **Weekend Membership**
 - Saturdays & Sundays, 8am – 9pm
- **Weekday Membership**
 - Monday – Friday, 8am – 9pm
- **Unlimited Membership**
 - Monday – Friday, 8am – 9pm; Weekends, 8am – 9pm

Mask Policy

- **Fully vaccinated members** may choose to remain maskless while at the Claremont MakerSpace. Please keep in mind that we have a wide range of members, including high risk and immunocompromised individuals. Members who would like to continue wearing masks, may continue to do so.

- **Members who are not fully vaccinated must continue to wear masks at all times when in the building.**
- By choosing to not wear a mask, you are confirming that you are fully vaccinated as per the CDC's definition.
- **Members of the public who are touring or visiting our facilities for any reason must wear masks at all times.**

Social Distancing

Regardless of vaccination status, we request that everyone continues to observe social distancing guidelines while in our facility. The CDC recommends 6 ft of distance between individuals.

Shared Personal Protective Equipment

- Shared Personal Protective Equipment continues to be unavailable.
- **Members must provide and use their own mandatory PPE** including, but not limited to safety glasses, hearing protection, etc. in order to safely use any shop or tool. Member supplied PPE must be commercially acceptable and specifically designed for the intended use.

Sign-in/Sign-Out

- Members shall continue to swipe their access card whenever entering the building.
- Sign-in and temperature checks at the front desk will no longer be required.

Exposure or Symptoms

- Members shall not enter the facility if they have had a positive COVID-19 test in the past 14 days or if they are

currently experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, regardless of vaccination status.

- Individuals who are not fully vaccinated are expected not to enter the facility if they have had:
 - COVID-19 symptoms in the past 14 days
 - Close contact with a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case in the past 14 days
 - Travelled out of the country in the last 14 days
- Anyone who learns they were potentially exposed to COVID-19 should contact us via email at info@claremontmakerspace.org to inform us.

Misc:

- All members are responsible for following and helping to encourage others to follow these rules in order to keep each other safe.
- Water drinking fountains shall not be used.

Claremont MakerSpace Volunteers and Staff will continue to:

- Clean bathrooms regularly.
- Clean high touch surfaces including doors, door knobs, light switches..
- Stock bathrooms with toilet paper, paper towels, soap and disinfectant.
- Stock cleaning supplies, disinfectant, paper towels, etc.

Future Changes

We will adjust these rules as needed, with or without notice, in order to comply with local, state and national regulations and to continue to implement best practices.
