

Claremont MakerSpace Member Access Rules

In order to ensure the safety of our members and community, the Claremont MakerSpace continues to adhere to New Hampshire and CDC guidelines regarding COVID-19 safety.

Members must read, and agree to abide by the terms, conditions, policies and procedures outlined here in order to continue to be granted access to the Claremont MakerSpace.

Members who fail to comply with these policies will have their access privileges suspended. We expect all members to comply with rules and requests made by our employees and volunteer staffers who are charged with ensuring the health and safety of the premises.

Access hours:

Normal membership level access hours continue to be in effect. You can access the MakerSpace during the hours specified by your membership level, which are:

- **Nights & Weekend Membership**
 - Monday – Friday, 5pm – 9pm; Weekends, 8am – 9pm
- **Weekend Membership**
 - Saturdays & Sundays, 8am – 9pm
- **Weekday Membership**
 - Monday – Friday, 8am – 9pm
- **Unlimited Membership**
 - Monday – Friday, 8am – 9pm; Weekends, 8am – 9pm

Mask Policy

- **Everyone must wear a mask covering their mouth and nose at all times while at the Claremont MakerSpace.**

Social Distancing

Regardless of vaccination status, we request that everyone continues to observe social distancing guidelines while in our facility. The CDC recommends 6 ft of distance between individuals.

Shared Personal Protective Equipment

- Shared Personal Protective Equipment continues to be unavailable.
- Members must provide and use their own mandatory PPE including, but not limited to safety glasses, hearing protection, etc. in order to safely use any shop or tool.
- Member supplied PPE must be commercially acceptable and specifically designed for the intended use.

Sign-in/Sign-Out

- Members shall continue to swipe their access card whenever entering the building.

Exposure or Symptoms

- Members shall not enter the facility if they have had a positive COVID-19 test in the past 14 days or if they are currently experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.
- Members shall not enter the facility if they have had close contact with a confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case in the past 14 days.
- Anyone who learns they were potentially exposed to COVID-19 shall promptly contact us via email at info@ClaremontMakerSpace.org to inform us.
- **Any member who tests positive for COVID-19 shall promptly notify us via email at info@ClaremontMakerSpace.org.**

Misc:

- All members are responsible for following and helping to encourage others to follow these rules in order to keep each other safe.
- Water drinking fountains shall not be used.

Claremont MakerSpace Volunteers and Staff will continue to:

- Clean bathrooms regularly.
- Clean high touch surfaces including doors, door knobs, light switches..
- Stock bathrooms with toilet paper, paper towels, soap and disinfectant.
- Stock cleaning supplies, disinfectant, paper towels, etc.

Please, if you aren't already, get vaccinated. None of us are safe from this thing until we are all safe from it, and getting vaccinated is the best way to protect yourself and others in the community. If you are vaccinated, get your booster shot to keep your immunity strong.
