

# Claremont MakerSpace Member Access Rules

In order to ensure the safety of our members and community, the Claremont MakerSpace continues to adhere to New Hampshire and CDC guidelines regarding COVID-19 safety.

Members must read, and agree to abide by the terms, conditions, policies and procedures outlined here in order to continue to be granted access to the Claremont MakerSpace.

Members who fail to comply with these policies will have their access privileges suspended. We expect all members to comply with rules and requests made by our employees and volunteer staffers who are charged with ensuring the health and safety of the premises.

## **Access hours:**

Normal membership level access hours continue to be in effect. You can access the MakerSpace during the hours specified by your membership level, which are:

- **Nights & Weekend Membership**
  - Monday – Friday, 5pm – 9pm; Weekends, 8am – 9pm
- **Weekend Membership**
  - Saturdays & Sundays, 8am – 9pm
- **Weekday Membership**
  - Monday – Friday, 8am – 9pm
- **Unlimited Membership**
  - Monday – Friday, 8am – 9pm; Weekends, 8am – 9pm

## **Mask Policy**

- Members, volunteers, and class attendees may choose to either wear, or not wear, masks according to their personal preferences.

- We ask that everybody please respect each others' personal decisions.

### **Social Distancing**

Please be aware that some members might be at higher risk for severe COVID-19 complications and they might ask that you give them some space.

### **Sign-in/Sign-Out**

- Members shall continue to swipe their access card whenever entering the building.

### **Exposure or Symptoms**

- In accordance with current CDC guidelines, if you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, Flu or other respiratory illness, please stay home until symptoms have passed.

### **Claremont MakerSpace Volunteers and Staff will continue to:**

- Clean bathrooms regularly.
- Clean high touch surfaces including doors, door knobs, light switches..
- Stock bathrooms with toilet paper, paper towels, soap and disinfectant.
- Stock cleaning supplies, disinfectant, paper towels, etc.
